Dear President Trump,

We write to you regarding the nomination process for the Board of Directors of the National Association of Registered Agents and Brokers (NARAB).

The National Association of Registered Agents and Brokers Reform Act (NARAB II) was enacted in January 2015 to establish NARAB, which will provide a national, standardized process for insurance agents and brokers to obtain eligibility to do business outside of their home states. NARAB II also established the NARAB Board of Directors, to consist of thirteen members appointed by the President with the advice and consent of the Senate, and tasked it with governing and supervising the activities of NARAB. However, more than four years after it was established, NARAB is still not operational because its Board of Directors has not yet been appointed.

We believe that NARAB will serve the important purpose of providing a streamlined licensing process that will reduce administrative redundancies and allow insurance agents and brokers to conduct business in more than one state through a single application. This will reduce compliance costs, promote consumer choice, and foster economic growth, all while continuing to preserve the state-based system of insurance regulation.

The administration has expressed support for NARAB in the Department of the Treasury's October 2017 report on asset management and insurance. The report also indicated that Treasury would quickly recommend NARAB Board nominees to the White House and would direct the Federal Insurance Office to solicit recommendations for nominees. We appreciate that expression of support and hope that it will quickly translate into the NARAB Board being filled.

In order for NARAB to become operational, we respectfully request that the administration proceed with the NARAB nomination process as soon as possible. Thank you, and we look forward to hearing from you on the status of the administration's NARAB nominees.
