Overview: During the time period of November 15 to November 22, there were **250,870 mentions** of Medicare for All-style proposals. Comparatively, net neutrality garnered **5,181 mentions** during the same time period.

As a result, candidates Elizabeth Warren and Bernie Sanders were one of the top topics of the week.




