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| Massachusetts | Medicare for All (H.2987/S.619) | On January 23, 2017, S.619 was introduced and referred to the Senate Committee on Health Care Financing. | New York | New York Health Act (A4738) | New York Assembly passed the N.Y. Health Act on May 16, 2017.
